

Study Tour Conditions of Application:

1. The information requested in the application form will be used for assessment purposes. All personal information collected during the application process may be made available to members of the selection committee.
2. The North Asia CAPE will normally hold documents about successful applicants for the duration of the award.
3. Consistent with the provisions of the Privacy Act applicants have the right of access to information held about them. Applicants also have the right to request the correction of information held about them.
4. The North Asia CAPE wishes to recognise successful applicants and keep informed about the process of the students they have supported. In accepting this award you authorise the North Asia CAPE to release information about your award and your experience. In addition you authorise the North Asia CAPE to request information on your academic status following the study tour.

Regulations:

1. Successful applicants will be known as North Asia CAPE Scholars.
2. Successful applicants must attend a ceremony celebrating their tour, if requested, and cooperate with any promotional publicity related to the study tour.
3. Successful applicants will be required to provide the North Asia CAPE with a final report on their study tour (guidelines will be provided)
4. The study tour will cover the cost of flights, internal transit and accommodation. These are chosen and paid for by the North Asia CAPE and remain inflexible.
5. The award will be made to a student undertaking study of Japanese at a first year university level, or JPLT N5.
6. The student must be available for travel between November 18, 2018 and December 1, 2018.
7. The student must comply with the rules and regulations of the host university.
8. The award is tenable only by a student who is a citizen or permanent resident of New Zealand.
9. The North Asia CAPE will make awards on the recommendation of the Selection Committee.
10. The North Asia CAPE has the power to terminate or suspend a study tour, if it receives an unsatisfactory report on the behaviour of a Scholar.
11. The North Asia CAPE is not obliged to make an award if in any year there is no candidate of sufficient merit.
12. Closing date: 20 August 2018.
13. The North Asia CAPE has the power to amend or vary these regulations.
