Overview:

Centres of Asia Pacific Excellence are committed to enhancing New Zealand's economic engagement and cultural understanding with the Asia-Pacific region. Together with the University of Waikato's Institute of Professional Learning (IPL) and the Education Bureau of Hangzhou, five New Zealand schools are invited to establish formal partnerships with counterpart schools in Hangzhou. Through IPL facilitation, schools will co-design and deliver a curriculum embedded programme of inter-cultural learning in areas of thematic or academic relevance, with opportunities for ongoing inquiry and teacher and learner exchange.

- \$8000 scholarship to cover teacher and principal release time and ongoing collaboration.
